Retire/Rehire Member Checklist

- I am at least 65 years old
- I have been retired from the department and eligible to receive my pension for at least three months.
- I am willing and able to submit to annual physicals so medical staff can certify that I am able to perform the duties of a firefighter, emergency responder, or law enforcement officer.
- I am aware that I cannot receive disability compensation if I am injured and that none of my additional time served can count toward my retirement.
- I have applied to be rehired at the department and have gone through their required application process.

District Retire / Rehire Checklist

- The member is at least 65 years old.
- The member has been retired from the department and eligible to receive their pension for at least three months.
- The department is willing to pay an additional surcharge for the member.
- The member has submitted an application to be rehired and has successfully completed our hiring process.
- The member has passed a physical and the treating medical staff has been able to certify that the member is physically capable of performing the duties of a firefighter, emergency responder, or law enforcement officer.
- A remittance form reporting the member, the physician's certification form (which is available at <http://www.bvff.wa.gov>), and any applicable fees have been sent to the BVFF & RO.
