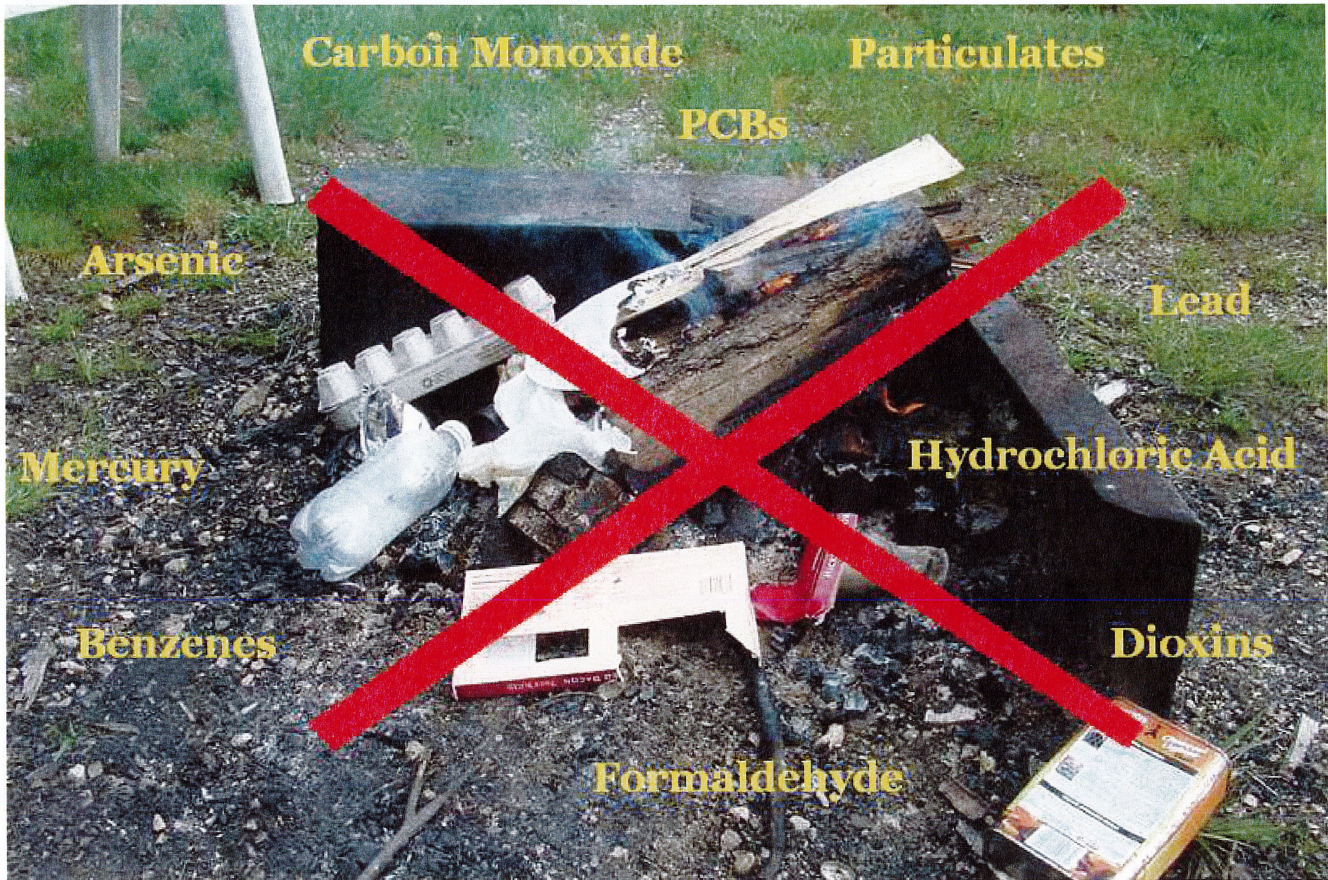


Burning garbage in a campfire leaves harmful pollutants in and around the area.

Breathing these pollutants has even been linked to premature death

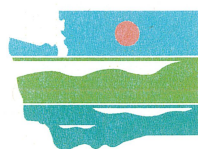
REMEMBER, it is only legal to burn untreated wood and enough paper to start the fire.
