

Grant County Fire Protection District 3

POLICY AND PROCEDURE

1. NUMBER: 2.2.6
2. SUBJECT: *Service Delivery Level - Contract Services*
3. POLICY: Grant County Fire District 3 will provide fire suppression or emergency medical contract services to other municipal corporations or private parties as described in this Policy and Procedure.
4. SCOPE: This Policy and Procedure is applicable to all personnel of Grant County Fire District 3.
5. RESPONSIBILITIES:
 - A. It shall be the responsibility of the Board of Commissioners and the District Fire Chief to enforce this policy and procedures.

6. PROCEDURE:

Grant County Fire District 3 may enter into contracts for the provision of services for the following groups or entities:

- A. Other municipal corporations which are exempt from paying property taxes that support these services such as (but not limited to) Grant County, The State of Washington (all departments and divisions), Quincy Columbia Basin Irrigation District, U.S. Dept. of Interior, Bureau of Land Management, U.S. Dept. of Agriculture, Forest Service and the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation and Grant County P.U.D.
- B. Public schools that lie within the District's boundaries.
- C. Individuals, businesses, or other groups that have property in areas where there is no organized governmental fire department.
- D. Other fire district's or fire departments when they request mutual aid.
- E. The District shall maintain current mutual aid contracts with neighboring

emergency service agencies that may be called upon in the event of a major incident within the District.

- F. Grant County Fire District 3 provides contractual services to the City of Quincy. The levels of services shall be as stipulated in the Inter-Local Agreement by and between Grant County Fire District 3 and the City of Quincy.
- G. The District may (from time-to-time) send contract engines to the Department of Natural Resources. In such instances, the terms and conditions of the Washington State Fire Mobilization Plan or an individually executed agreement shall apply.
- H. When a contract for services is in place with any other public or private agency or individual, the terms of the contract for services with said agency or individual shall apply.
