***Wildland Urban Interface Firefighting  
for the Structural Company Officer***

**May 4-5, 2024**

This is two-day course identifies operational activities and safety concerns for structural company officers assigned to a Wildland/Wildland Urban Interface incident. Topics covered include Introduction to Wildland/Wildland Urban Interface firefighting, interface environment, wildland fire behavior, command and control issues of wildland/urban interface firefighting, and tactics.

The goal of this course is to Identify the various operational activities and safety considerations for the structural Company Officer (CO) assigned to a Wildland Urban Interface (WUI) incident. The Purpose is to provide students with the ability to identify the WUI environment, contrast it with structural firefighting, and implement appropriate operational and command activities for this environment.
